Troy Junior High Dress Code:

<u>Teachers will check students each day in 1st period.</u>

Philosophy: Student dress should not distract from the education process nor present a safety risk or hazard to the student or other students.

1. Shirts:

- a. Both shoulders must be covered (no single strap tops)
- b. No spaghetti strap tanks (same standard for boys and girls)
- c. No bra straps showing
- d. NO LOW CUT tops (from both standing and sitting perspectives)
- e. Shirts need to be long enough to completely cover the back and stomach of a student at ALL TIMES

2. Bottoms:

- a. NO SPANDEX pants or LEGGINGS, unless appropriately covered
- b. NO tube skirts
- c. Shorts must cover student appropriately and not be too tight.
- d. Pants/shorts should be worn appropriately, around waist, with no undergarments visible

3. Pants:

a. No extremely shredded pants or pants with holes that do not cover areas that appropriate shorts would cover.

Course of action:

- a. Student should be given the opportunity to cover with a sweatshirt/tshirt. Teachers will then inform the rest of the team that the student should remain wearing the sweatshirt for the day.
- b. If no alternative appropriate attire is available, student should be sent to the office.
